Gift Aid

To increase the value of your membership, the Wildlife Trust used to be able to claim Gift Aid, increasing the value of your subscription by almost 30%, at no extra cost to you. This scheme has been revised and we are no longer able to reclaim tax relief on company donations, we now have to request the tax benefit direct from you when you pay your membership. In order to claim the tax relief your company would include this payment in your Corporation Tax return. As an example, a donation of £128 gross will only cost the company £100 when they claim tax relief, when calculating their profits for taxation purposes.
