Smooth newt (m)

Frogs have longer legs than toads, this helps them to hop.
Toads prefer to crawl so have much shorter legs.
Frogs tend to have smooth, slimy skin and toads are dry and warty.
Generally female and male newts look similar but during breeding season male newts change their appearance.
Great crested newts are bigger (13em or more in length), smooth and palmate newts are smaller (up to llem)
Palmate newts can be distinguished from smooths by

the tail filament and dark webbing on their back feet.
