## Welcome to The Knapp and Papermill nature reserve

This unique nature reserve lies in and around a winding stream valley with old woods, meadows and an orchard.

The circular nature trail is just under two miles long and there are connecting footpaths and permissive paths to take you into the wider countryside. Most paths are unsurfaced and can be uneven, muddy and steep in places. There is a set of steps and we ask you to please leave gates as you find them as there can be livestock grazing the meadows.
